Notice of Public Meeting and Agenda

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of Orange County Emergency Services District No. 3 (the "District") will meet in special session on **Wednesday, August 26, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Central Fire Station located at 8465 Hwy 87 North, Orange, Texas 77632**, with possible conference calls.

The Board will discuss, consider, and possibly take action on the following matters:

1. Call to Order
2. Public Comments
3. Committee Reports
4. Discuss, consider and take action to amend the Commissioners Regular District Meeting August 11, 2026 action regarding the 2026 tax rate.
5. Discuss, consider, and take action regarding the proposal and notice of the District's 2026 property tax rate under applicable Truth-in-Taxation requirements, including:
 - a. Discussing and taking a record vote to propose a 2026 Maintenance and Operations (M&O) tax rate and a 2026 Debt Service / Interest and Sinking (I&S) tax rate, which combined may exceed the No-New-Revenue tax rate for Orange County ESD 3.
 - b. Setting the date, time, and place for a public meeting to vote on the final adoption of the proposed 2026 tax rate.
 - c. Authorize publication, website posting, and posting at Station 1 of the required notices regarding 2026 property tax rate as required by law.
6. Report from Fire Department Personnel; and
7. Executive session, as necessary:
 - a. Adjourn to Executive Session, as necessary, to discuss matters concerning pending or contemplated litigation or consultation with an attorney, real property, or personnel matters, as authorized by Texas Government Code Sections 551.071, 551.072, and 551.074;
 - b. Reconvene in Open Session; and
 - c. Vote on matters discussed in Executive Session, if any.

The meeting will be open to the public at all times in compliance with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended (the "Texas Open Meetings Act"). This notice shall be posted for at least three business days preceding the scheduled day of such meeting. The Board reserves the right to convene a closed session with respect to any item listed on the agenda where any exception exists under the Texas Open Meetings Act. The right to convene such a closed session shall exist regardless of whether or not the agenda item or items expressly state that a closed meeting will be convened.
